FIRST: CERT setting up & incident handling guide, exercise material




 Support for setting up CERTs in eastern African countries, e.g. Kenya, Tanzania.

**NOTE**: Not exhaustive list of EU initiatives!






# **ENISA** international cooperation (cont'd)
